



Wrightwood Chamber of Commerce Chili Cook-Off Entry Form

October 9, 2021 • 11 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Categories: Red ~ Green ~ Anything Goes



1. Participants get a 10'x10' booth space and are responsible for providing their own cooking stove and fuel, (no LP tanks larger than 10 pounds allowed), cooking utensils, tables and chairs, appliances and optional canopy. Individual ingredients may be prepped ahead but must be brought in separate containers or cans; **assembling chili in advance is NOT allowed**. Access to electricity is available upon request. Extension cords are not provided. All booths must be in compliance with San Bernardino County Environmental Health Department regulations.
2. Participant check-in begins at 7:00 am; booth set up should be completed by 8:30 a.m. All cars need to be parked in Vendor Parking on the north side of Hwy 2. at this time - not on public streets.
3. A list of ingredients (not the recipe) must be turned in to the Chamber booth no later than 9:00 a.m. the day of the event or with the application.
4. Contestants must prepare at least five (5) gallons of Chili for tasting purposes. Selling of chili is not allowed. **Sampling cups and a small ladle** will be provided to each contestant. Contestants need to have some type of tray to serve the samplings from. Please return the ladle at the end of the event to the Chamber Booth.
5. **Chili will be judged on:** Aroma, Appearance, Consistency, Taste and Aftertaste on a 1 – 5 point rating scale by the judges. Containers will be provided for judging. Chili needs to be ready at 11:30 a.m. for the judges blind tasting.
6. Tasting kits include sampling tickets and a People's Choice ticket. People's Choice tickets are different in color than the sampling ticket. Please collect a ticket from each person before giving them their sample. These can be tossed.
7. The Award Ceremony is at 2:30 p.m. and contestants need to be present. Cash prizes will be awarded for each category and for the People's Choice selection.
8. The event continues until 4:00 p.m. Booths may not be disassembled and vehicles cannot enter the area until the event closes.
